JANUARY TASKS FROM THE TENNESSEE HOME FRUIT AND VEGETABLE CALENDAR

January is the ideal month for planning out your garden and gathering supplies.

Tasks:

- 1. Prepare a garden plan. Remember to follow a rotation of crop families.
- 2. Prepare your seed and transplant orders. Keep in mind that Lawrence County is in USDA hardiness zone 7b.
- 3. Test germination of leftover seeds.
- 4. Remove last season's plant and fruit residue from garden beds and planting sites to reduce risk of disease.

JANUARY TASKS FROM THE LAWN MAINTENANCE CALENDAR

All Grass Types:

- Set goals/objectives for the upcoming year.
- Consider what issues you faced last year.
 Did you struggle with weeds, diseases, or insects?

Bermudagrass/Zoysiagrass:

- Now is your window to control winter weeds with a non-selective herbicide.
 - Only apply non-selective herbicides when bermudagrass is completely dormant and air temperatures are greater than 55 F.
