Members of the 4-H program have the opportunity to join a 4-H Judging team! Judging teams provide a chance to learn more about a particular subject, meet new people, and travel to different places. Plus, judging teams are FUN

<u>Life Skills</u>—This contest teaches important life skills, such as how to make change, set a table, and prevent food borne illnesses. Team work together and individually.

<u>Meat identification</u>—This Judging team teaches you have to identify various cuts of meat from cattle, sheep, and swine.

<u>Land</u>—like to play in the soil? If so, this team is for you! Members learn about soil composition, slop and erosion.

<u>Livestock</u>—members of this team learn ways to properly select cattle, sheep, hogs, and goats.

<u>Horse</u>—If you like horses this may be the team for you! Members learn more about horse conformation and movements.

<u>Horse Bowl/Hippology</u>—if you are interested in learning more about horses, pick this team! Students participate in a quiz bowl contest, testing their knowledge of horses. Members learn about the parts of horse nutrition, tack and equipment.

<u>Outdoor Meat Cookery</u>—this contest is for those who love to grill! Teams of four each grill a cut of meat from beef, pork, poultry, and lamb. Using original recipes and creating a grilling theme, this contest is sure to satisfy!

<u>Wildlife</u>—this contest allows members to learn more about Tennessee wildlife. Students learn identifying traits, such as habitat, and food choices of various types of wildlife.

<u>Consumer Decision Making</u>— Like to go shopping? This contest allows members to learn how to make informed decisions on consumer goods. This is a team contest or individual.
